A remarkable feature of Angama Mara is its direct private airstrip access into the Mara Triangle. This is where some of the loveliest scenes from the film Out of Africa were filmed.

Day 1

Arrive Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, Nairobi
Private road transfer to the Wilson Airport (approximately 30 min) for charter flight to the Angama Mara's private airstrip in the Maasai Mara (flight costs not included)
Lunch served at the lodge
Welcome off-site reception with a performance by Maasai warriors
Return to the lodge for dinner

Day 2

Morning 4x4 jeep safari in the Mara Triangle followed by a bush breakfast
Lunch at the lodge
After lunch, a visit to the local Maasai school where the learners will entertain the group with songs and dance of their culture. Guests will present the headmaster with gifts of stationery for the children
Enjoy Angama Mara's signature bush BBQ, just 5 minutes from the lodge

Day 3

Optional Hot Air Balloon experience (for own account)
Morning 4x4 jeep safari towards the Tanzanian border
Picnic lunch en-route
The farewell dinner will be an elegant celebration at the Pavilion next to the pool, lit by hundreds of lanterns bringing the day to a beautiful end. Ladies will be presented with personalised bracelets and a beautiful Maasai necklace and the men will all receive beaded rungas (walking sticks), also personalized

Return flight Angama Mara Airstrip to Wilson Airport and then transfer to Jomo Kenyatta Airport for international flight home (flight costs not included)
